COMPETING TEAMS COMPOSITION

Teams are composed as follows:

- **Junior** Teams ages 8 12 (3 participants per team)
- **Senior** Teams ages 13 18 (3 participants per team) Young people who have basic knowledge of computing.
- Teachers' Teams (2 participants per team)

Teachers in Secondary Schools either self-sponsored or nominated by their school principals, who have basic knowledge of computing (that is, the ability to boot a system, and handle the mouse and word processing).

TRANSPORTATION

DIGITEST

DIGITEST, an initiative of Digital Peers International (DPI), is a 2-week information and communications technology (ICT) based creative camp and competition, organized annually since the year 2000.

DIGITEST is aimed at creating ICT awareness, promoting technology literacy, Science, and Technology, and developing requisite ICT skills, knowledge, and capabilities among the nation's children and youth, ages 8-18. Our main objective, amongst others, is to bridge the digital divide between African Children and their counterparts globally.

DIGITEST provides a platform for participants to learn the appreciation of the computer and various ICT applications for problem-solving and thereafter break into teams of three participants per team. The teams compete to find the best solutions for selected annual themes representing challenges in Nigeria.

DIGITEST 2023 is a ten-day camp with full boarding facilities (feeding and accommodation) for young people ages 8-18 years and teachers from all over Africa.

OBJECTIVES OF DIGITEST 2023

- To further generate and develop ICT-based solutions to Plastic Waste Management based on ideas generated by the 200 Youths in Phase I of the SGP Project
- As usual with DIGITEST to re-focus youthful energies to gainful activities
- To develop APPs, Animation, and other soft skills that could be easily shared within and outside Nigeria.
- To use digital skills in helping participants access new employment opportunities and to develop an Entrepreneurial spirit
- Encouraging national and international networking for young people.

CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS



- Campers must be competitors, staff or facilitators, and support staff.
- Campers are expected to arrive in camp with 1 travel box (1 Standard Luggage box) to be checked in on arrival at the camp venue.
- Participants are expected to be punctual and attend all events in the camp.
- Lateness to programs is not tolerated.
- Participants are not allowed to leave camp without the permission of the camp commandant.
- Dropping out of a group movement is not allowed.
- Only competing students and teachers, camp executives, and facilitators will be permitted on camp.
- Visiting is highly discouraged but permissible under the supervision of the camp commandant.
- Eating is restricted to designated areas and must not be done inside the computer rooms.
- Provocative dressing is **not allowed** on camp.
- Campers are **required** to have the following:
- Pocket money (not exceeding N10,000 for young people, to be deposited with Official DIGITEST Chaperons on arrival in Camp). Any money not so deposited is kept by the participant in question at the participant's own risk. Clothes include sportswear, trainers, bathroom slippers, socks, trainers, cardigans, jeans, complete native attire, and a beauty pageant outfit (If you have plans to participate in the beauty pageant, come with an English outfit and a traditional outfit)
 - Mosquito net, cover cloths, bed sheet, and pillowcase.
 - Toiletries, toothbrush & paste, bathing soap, body cream, shampoo, sponge case, etc.
 - Any 'already' **prescribed** medication.



Participants in the camp are permitted to bring laptops, phones, and flash drives, but they do so entirely
at their own risk. During specific times at camp, the use of phones will be allowed. However, it is
important to note that all types of storage devices, including phones and cameras, must be handed over
to the Official DIGITEST Chaperones for safekeeping, as the use of such devices is prohibited throughout
the competition period.

Following items are prohibited in camp:

- Cash on students
- Food and provisions
- Alcoholic substances, hard drugs, and smoking are prohibited on camp. Participants caught will be expelled from the camp.
- Telephone services, provisions, and toiletries will be available under DIGITEST Tuck Shop.

REFUND POLICY

- Refund possible only six (6) weeks before the commencement of the program.
- All refunds would be made in the manner that payments were made.
